Statement on REACH/RoHS/Hazardous substances

With regard to the normative directives resulting from EU Regulation 1907/2006 (REACH) and EU Directive RoHS (2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU), we would like to issue our customers with the following statement:

EU Regulation EC 1907/2006 (REACH) and EU Regulation 2020/171 REACH

The provisions of the REACH Regulation relating to registration of hazardous materials in electrical and electronic appliances apply to

- Manufacturers and importers of materials,
- Suppliers of materials and preparations,
- Manufacturers and importers of products which, under normal and foreseeable conditions of use, release substances.

As we do not supply materials or preparations, but solely supply products for measurement and control technology, the requirement for registration under the terms of the REACH Regulation, in the framework of the premises stated above, does not apply. Nevertheless, we consider ourselves in principle obliged to inform our customers if our products contain substances of very high concern (SVHC) at levels of > 0.1 mass %. (European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) <http://echa.europa.eu>).

According to the extent of today's knowledge and the information provided by our suppliers, we can confirm to you that the products we supply do not contain > 0.1 mass % of materials from the candidate list (SVHC list of July 8, 2021) as defined in article 59 of the above-mentioned regulation. In the event that our products contain SVHC materials at a higher concentration, we will inform you immediately.

EU Directive RoHS (2011/65/EU, formerly 2002/95/EC)

With regard to complying with the provisions resulting from EU Directives WEEE (2012/19/EU, formerly 2002/96/EC) and RoHS (2011/65/EU, formerly 2002/95/EC), we can confirm that our products are assigned to group 9 (monitoring and control instruments), in accordance with appendix IA of the WEEE Directive and meet the RoHS 2011/65 / EU and WEEE 2012/19 / EU directives.

EU Directive 2015/863 / EU (RoHS 3)

This Directive extends annex II of the RoHS Directive by a further four substances to a total of 10, valid from 22 July 2021, for our products, that belong to category 9, industrial monitoring and control instruments. We declare that our products comply with directive 2015/863 / EU (ROHS 3).

Irrespective of this, we would like to inform you that the EU Regulations that apply to our equipment are detailed in the declarations of conformity supplied with the individual equipment. These form part of the operating instructions that are included with every delivery.
